



## All members meeting Minutes March 9, 2015

### REPORTS:

- **President- Curt**
  - Overall things are going well for the guild. We have 6 months in cash reserves in the bank. Membership is full and has been for a while.
- **Vice President/Facilities – Stephen**
  - We're still working on getting AC in the hand-building room.
  - With a full membership we're going through lots of clay.
  - Last few months of 2014 we only had about 3 bags of clay missing; first few months of 2015 we had about 13 bags of clay missing.
- **Treasurer - Abigail**
  - The extra money that PayPal has been holding on to from our classes has been transferred to our bank account.
  - New policy, members are now locked out and membership terminated after 90 days of nonpayment of dues.
  - \$61,838.92 in checking and savings.
  - \$2,000 budgeted on a new website; this is not preventing the guild from repairing the kilns, purchasing needed equipment etc.
  - \$5,000 has been budgeted for Potters with a Purpose, to go towards the studio tour, helping the community and local schools with firings etc.
- **Tyke Wortman & Liz Stroh & Christina Hellyer – 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration**
  - June 27<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup> Open house / Studio Tour
    - Demos will be scheduled, donated pots will be sold and money donated to Cross Roads Safe House
    - Week before, Saturday June 20, a “mugging” in old town is scheduled
      - Donated mugs will be given away to advertise the Studio Tour
  - May 30<sup>th</sup> Demonstration from a guest potter – Sam Harvey – for members only
    - Giveaways for members including gift certificates, maybe T-shirts etc.
- **Joe Aiken – Potters with Purpose**
  - Collects pottery at the end of our shows from members to use for donation requests
  - Pots may be left on Joe's shelf at the guild anytime if you would like to donate
  - The guild sent over \$1,100 in donated pots for Empty Bowls
- **Toshie Matsumura – Spring Show & Fundraiser May 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>**
  - Wednesday March 25, 6:00pm is the all participants meeting
  - Clean up will happen the week of April 20<sup>th</sup>, final clean up on the morning of the 25<sup>th</sup> and setup starts at 10am that day. Guild will not be a functioning studio starting the 25<sup>th</sup> until after the show.
